1 OVERVIEW

This document reports on the second round of in-country workshops held as part of the RECerT project.

The second round of in-country workshops were held in thirteen countries between 19 March and 11 April 2001. Approximately 360 people attended the workshops.

The main purpose of the workshops was to introduce participants to the TGC trading simulation, RECerT-sim. The workshops aimed to explain the principles of the simulation and recruit participants to it, as well as train participants in how to use the websites and software and take part in the simulation. For this reason only a short introductory presentation was made on the current status of TGC developments in Europe and on other aspects of the project. The bulk of the workshop time was dedicated to explaining RECerT-sim, and the way in which workshop participants may take part in it.

Invitations for the workshops (see annex 1) placed an emphasis on RECerT-sim, and were aimed at a smaller number of invitees than the first round of country workshops. The first round of country workshops, between May and September 2000, were designed for a large audience, and covered a range of topics. The second round workshops lasted usually half a day, reflecting the focus on RECerT-sim, whereas the first round workshops were full-day events.

2 TIMETABLE

Thirteen workshops were held, in late March to early April 2001, in every participating country except France, Luxembourg and Ireland. The Luxembourg workshop was combined with the Belgian one, and in the absence of a French workshop, French participants in the simulation were contacted directly with information. The Irish workshop was cancelled due to the epidemic of foot and mouth disease, but Irish participants in the simulation were contacted directly.

In addition to the country workshops, the principles and design of RECerT-sim were presented at the Stockholm RECS plenary meeting in April 2001, further extending the number of organisations covered by this workshop series.

A total of approximately 360 people attended the workshops. In-country organisation of the workshops was provided by the RECerT country partners.
